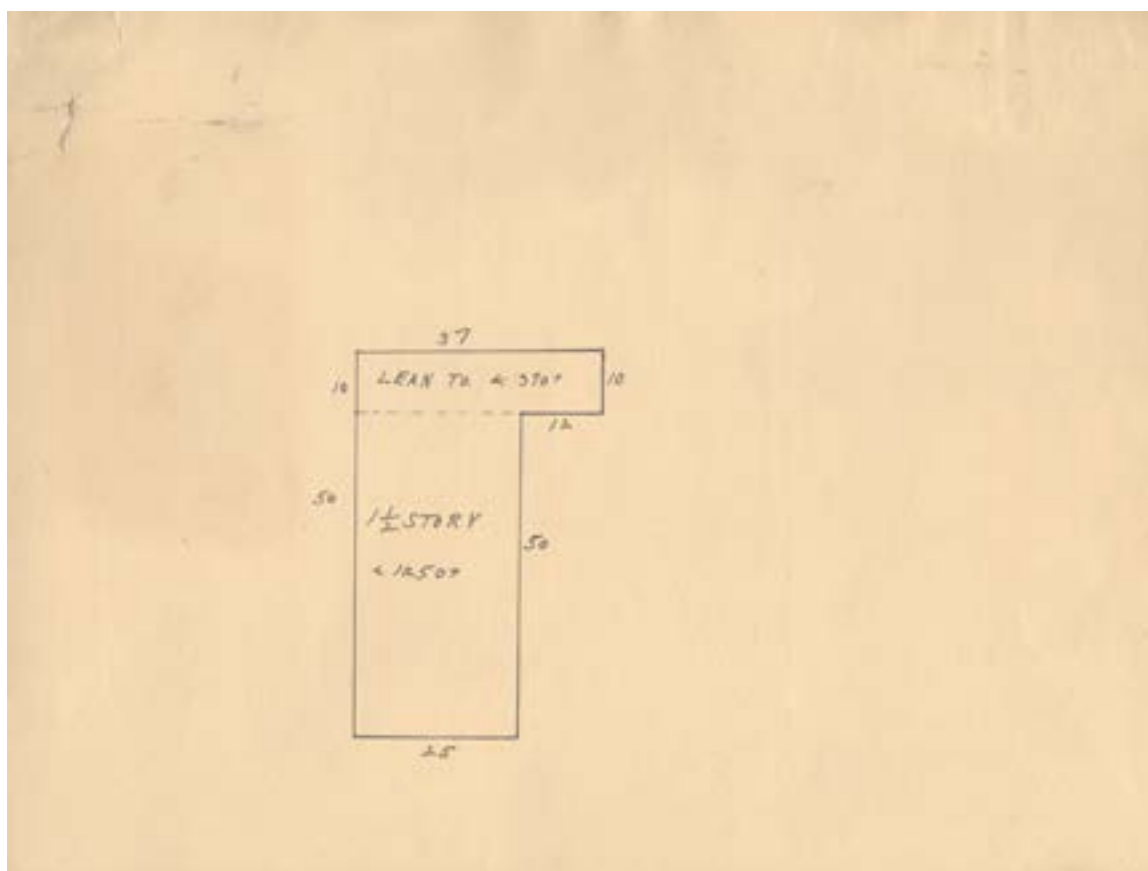

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY Paint fair, roof good.

BOOK 1285 PAGE 500 March 26, 1928

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situate in said Bridgton, and in Bridgton Center Village and on the Easterly side of Depot Street, and bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commence on the Easterly side of said Depot Street at a point on the said side line thereof two hundred and eighty-four (284) feet Northerly of the Northeasterly corner of the Northerly abutment of the bridge in said Street, said point marked by an iron pipe supposed to be on or near said Street's said line but to govern only as to fixing the distance from said bridge abutment; thence North fifty-eight (58) degrees and thirty (30) minutes East to the brook or outlet of the ditches on the Walker Meadow, so called; thence Northerly by said brook a sufficient distance to make the lot hereby located forty feet wide when measured at right angles to it's North and South lines; thence South fifty-eight degrees (58) and thirty (30) minutes West to a point on said Depot Street's said Easterly line forty (40) feet North of a point thereon of commencement; thence Southerly by said Street to said point thereon of commencement.
