



Boston May 19th 1847

My dear Miss Mountfort,

I thank you for your letter which was so promptly sent, I received it the day after it was put into the Portland Post Office. I wish I could occasionally know some private opportunity to send, that we might not so often trouble you and your mother with our commission to Hager but we have known of no one going to Portland for a great while, and therefore feel grateful to you for permitting us to direct to your care.

We are exceedingly sorry to hear Hager suffers so much, but can only hope that her sufferings may be shortlived. Tell her if you please, Mr. Stevenson died about a month since (old Mr. S. I mean.) We enclose six dollars, which you will be so kind as to hand to Hager.
