


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

John A.&Maty E. Tuttle: bounded as follows: Commencing on said side of said Street and at the Southeasterly corner thereas of the house lot originally sold by Charles Gibbs to Arthur S. Winn, and thence run Westerly by the southerly side line of said Winn-lot, and continuing on the same sourse for a distance of \$28 feet by and the same, making the full distance run (140) feet to a pipe driven in the ground; thence southerly and parallel with said Portland Street, (70) feet to an iron pipe driven aforesaid; thence easterly and on the course which will parallel with the southerly side line of said Winn-lot (the same being S. (80%) degrees E in 1902 (140) feet to said Portland Street and thence northerly by said Portland Street, (70) feet to the point begun at.
