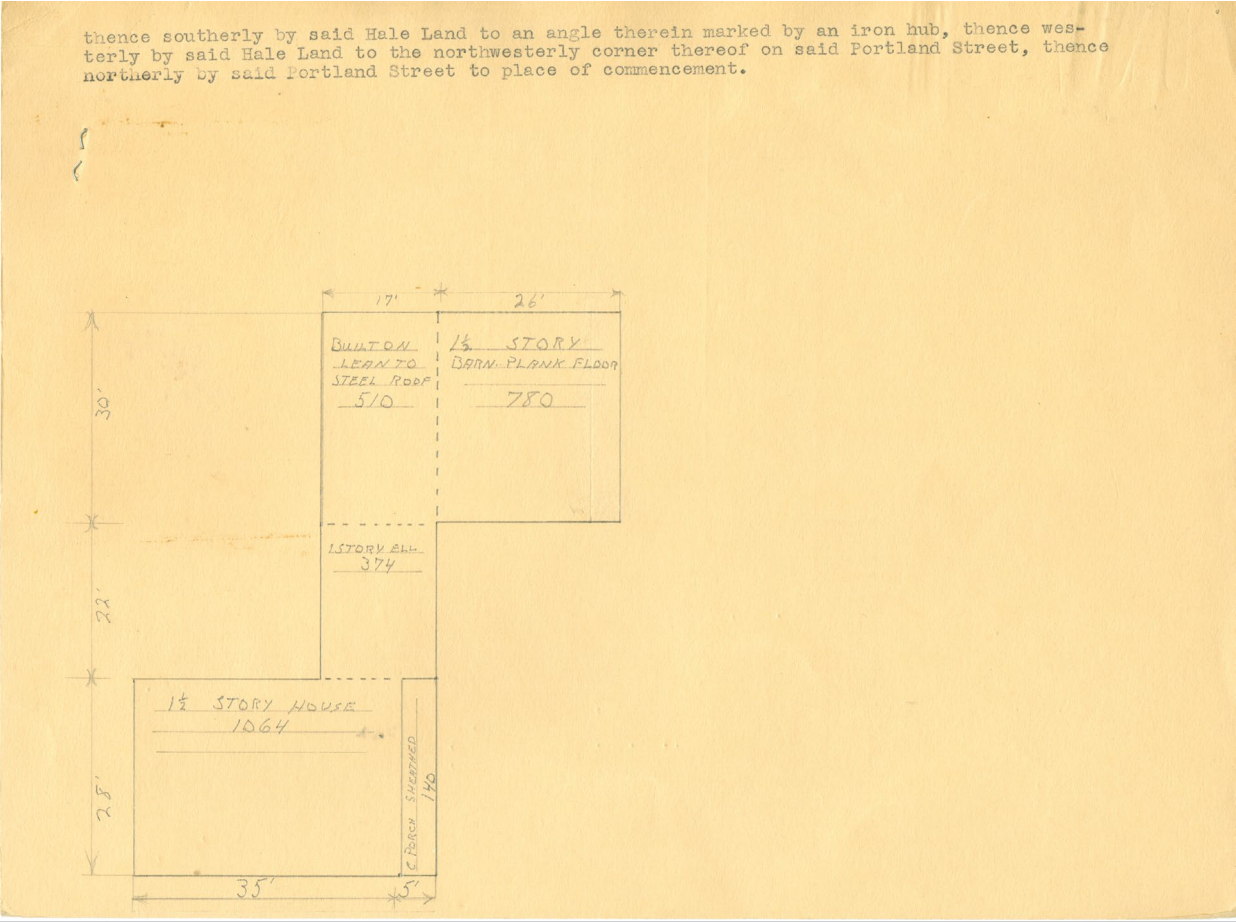
DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Good condition.

Aug. 27, 1934

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A parcel of land situated in said Bridgton a part of Lot #7 in the 14th range and bounded as follows: Commence on the easterly side of Portland Street and the northwesterly corner thereof of the premises hereby conveyed and the southwesterly corner of land of Charles L. Moynihan, marked by an iron hub set in the ground, thence north 79 degrees and 15' east, about 10 rods to the center of a ditch marked by an iron hub, thence northerly and following the center of said ditch to land of Col. H. D. Littlefield, thence easterly by the southerly line of said Littlefield Land to land of Albert Gray, marked by an iron hub in the ground, thence southerly by westerly line of Gray Homestead to southwesterly corner thereof marked by an iron hub; thence easterly by the southerly line of Gray's premises to an iron hub set in the ground to a large apple tree, thence southerly by westerly line of said Gray's premises to an iron hub on the land of Minta Hale near a red oak tree, thence westerly said Hale land to the northwesterly corner thereof marked by an iron hub,
