

Book 1590, page 395: A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, being a part of lot #7 in the 13th Range of lots in said Fridgton, and bounded and described as follows: Commence on the easterly side of Flint Street so called at the southwesterly comer of land of Maurice Hamblen; thence easterly 7 and 7/8 rods more or less by the southerly line of said Hamblen land to an iron pipe driven in the ground near a hard pine tree, the post marking the northeasterly corner of the premises hereby conveyed and the northwesterly corner of lot of Myrtle Graffam; thence southerly by land of said Graffam and continuing on the same course and in a straight line 6 and 5/8 rods more or less, to an iron post driven in the ground by a stone wall on line of land of archine Woolley; thence westerly by the



northerly side line of said Woolley land 8 and 11/16 rods more or less to said Flint Street; and theme northerly by said Flint Street, 62 rods to the point of commencement. Subject to a right of way for the owners and occupants of the homestead premises now owned by Myrtle Graffam and located easterly of thus and adjoining the above described premises by wehicles or in any other manner and for any purpose whatsoever from said Graffam premises through the dooryard of the premises hereby conveyed, and over the driveway as now used, to said Flint Street.
