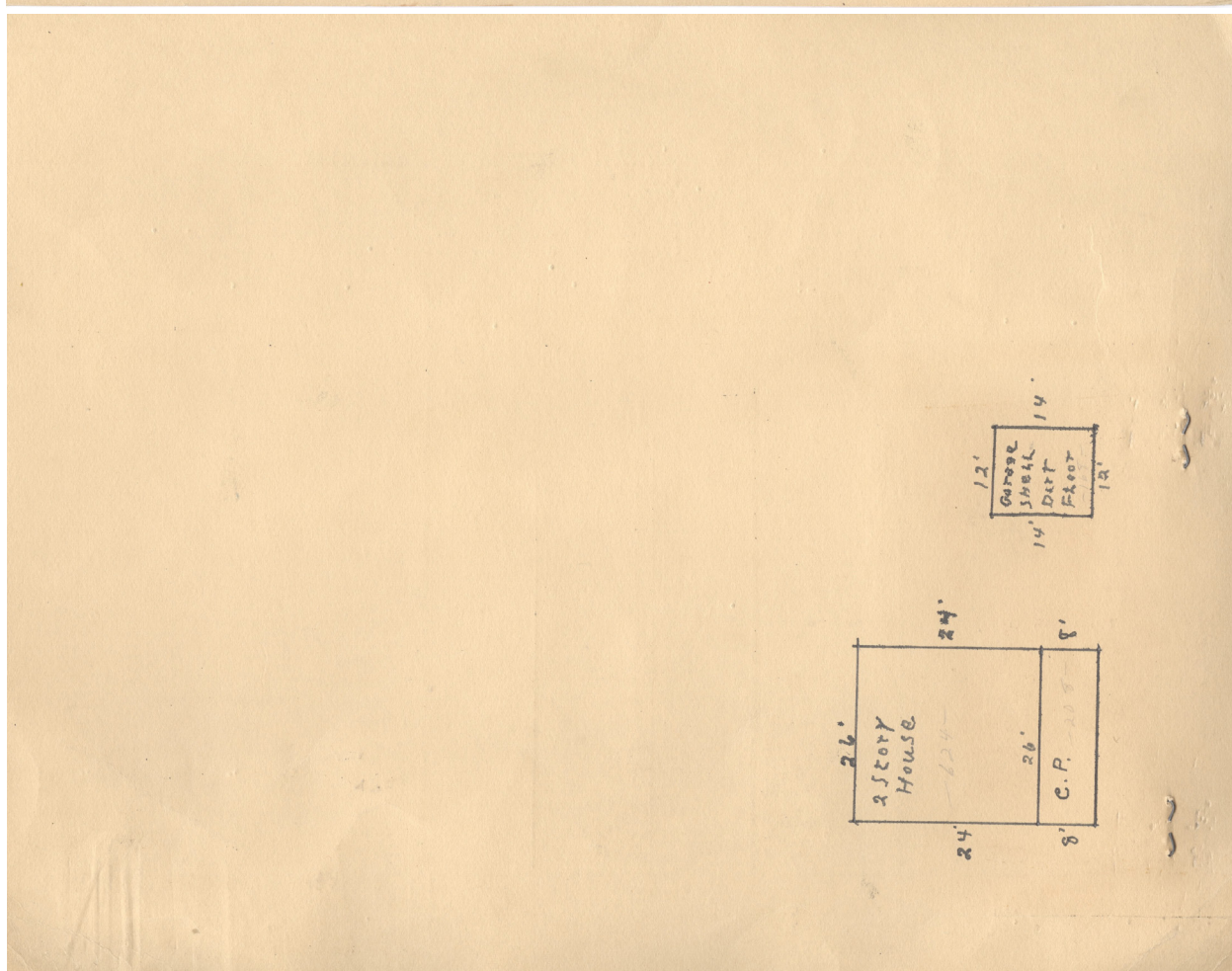


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY Roof and paint good.

BOOK 1498 **PAGE 265** **June 17, 1936.**

5 Cottage Street, Charles B. and Bertha Sanborn, bounded as follows;- Commence at the southeasterly corner of the homestead premises of Burton M. Thomas on said side of said street; thence run easterly on said street 50ft. to an iron pipe set in the ground making the Southwesterly corner of land of A. C. Maxim; thence Northerly on the Westerly line of said Maxim's land 150 ft. more or less to land of Delmore Robinson; thence Westerly on the Southerly line of said Robinson's land 50 ft. more or less to the Northeastly corner of said Burton M. Thomas premises and thence Southerly by the easterly line of said Thomas premises to the point of commencement and bound first mentioned, the last course being the one hundred and fifty (150) feet, more or less.
