





DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

12 Story Fair Condition. Warranty deed from Alma S. Oberg to Edward F. Haggett, et al, Dated
June 28, 1934 State of Maine Cumberland County Registry of Deeds Received Sept. 13, 1934. Recorded
in Book 1451, Page 310. From the office J. B. Pike. Know all men by these presents, that I Alma S.
Oberg of Bridgton, in the County of Cumberland and State of Maine. In consideration of one dollar and
other valuable consideration paid by Edward F. Haggett and Christine A. Haggett, husband and wife, both
of Bridgton aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give Grant Bargin, sell
and coney unto the said Edward F. Haggett and Christine A. Haggett as joint tenants and not as tenants
in common his owner heirs and assigns forever. A certain lot or parcel of land with buildings
theron a part of lot numbered (7) in the 13th (13) Range of lot in the town of Bridgton and on the
southerly side of Bennett St, in Bridgton Center Village and bounded as follows: Commence on said side
of said street at the northwesterly corner. Therefore of the premises deeded by Alice M. Bradstreet and
Etta L. Otis to one Emma A. Perry and at one time owned by Sara N. Wilson thence run South (63) degrees
and (15) minutes west by said Wilson premises to land formerly owned by Isaac Webb, a stone wall being
the line thereof. Thence Northwesterly and by said stone wall to the southeasterly corner of the
premises deeded by said Bradstreet and Otis to one Kate Dunn; thence Northeasterly and by said Dunn

premises (This course in 1894 being N 59½ degrees East) To said Bennett Street and thence southeasterly by said street to the point thereon begun at and bound at first mention. I derive my title to the above described real estate by will of my late husband P.H.P. Oberg which was duly proved and allowed in the Probate Court of Cumberland County. The above described real estate is subject to a certain mortgage given by the grantor to the Home Laan Corporation to secure the amount of \$94.95 which mortgage and note thereby secured the grantees assume and agree to pay as a part and consideration for this deed and they further agree to hold the grantor harmless thereon. To have and to hold the aforegranted and bargained premises withall the privileges and appartenences thereof to the said Edwardf. Haggett and Christine A. Haggett as joint tenants and not as tenants in common. His or her heirs and assigns, to them and their use and behoof forever, I do convenent with the said grantees, their heeirs and assigns that I am lawfully sized in fee of the premises and that are free from all incumberences, except as above stated and that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said grantees to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my heairs shall and will warrant and defend the same to the said grantees, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
