Description: Back-Cove Bridge Subscription form, Portland, 1830

Free Bridge Subscription.

Whereas it is of great public importance that a Free Bridge should be built across Back-Cove, connecting Portland with the Country, and whereas an Act of Incorporation has been granted, the better to effect this very important object. Now, in consideration that said Proprietors and their Associates, will go forward to build a Free Bridge, in conformity to the grant, or in case they should judge it most for the public good to buy out the Proprie-tors of Back-Cove Bridge, and make of it a Free Bridge, we covenant, promise and agree to pay to said pro-prietors of said Free Bridge, the respective sums set against our names, and so to pay as to enable them to go forward with the work.
