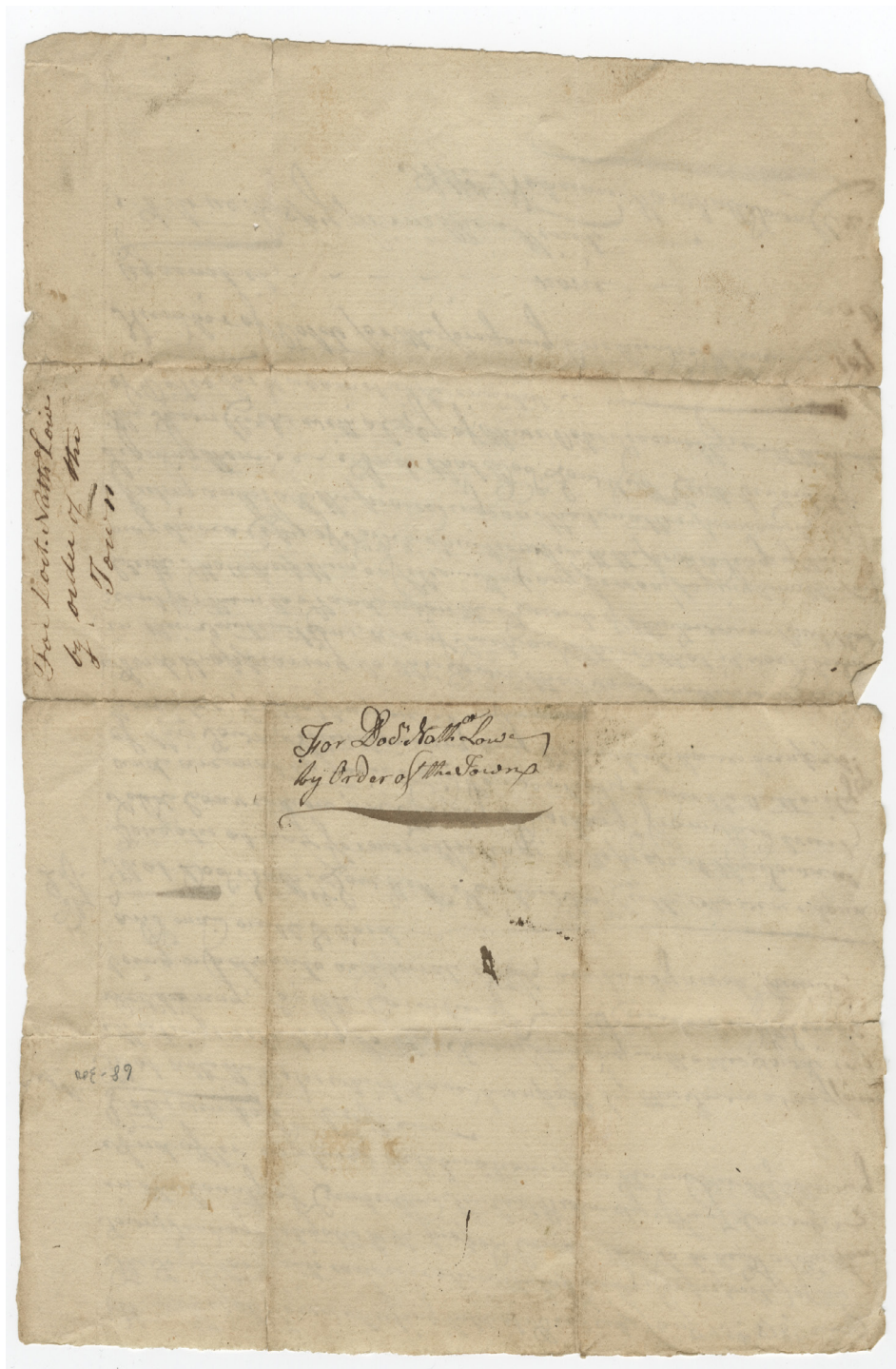


At a Legal Town Meeting held at Berwick Jan<sup>y</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> 1787  
 The Town took into consideration the Expediency, (or propriety) of this  
 Town, sending Delegates to the proposed Convention to be held at Gorham  
 in the County of Cumberland, the last Wednesday of Jan<sup>y</sup> current.  
 And after mature deliberation upon the matter the following  
 Votes were pass<sup>d</sup>. Vizt<sup>t</sup>  
 1<sup>st</sup> That all the Votes which have been pass<sup>d</sup>. by this Town at any former  
 Meeting, relating to this Town joining with other Towns in  
 petitioning, for the Counties of York, Cumberland & Lincoln  
 being incorporated as separate States, are hereby revoked, recinded,  
 and made null & void  
 2<sup>d</sup> That Doc<sup>r</sup> Nath<sup>l</sup>, Low, & M<sup>r</sup>. Richard [Fo?] Cutts, who were chosen  
 Delegates at any former Meeting, to represent this Town at  
 said Convention are hereby Discharged from said trust  
 and are not to join said Conventions, under the Authority  
 of this Town, Notwithstanding any Vote which have been pass<sup>d</sup>.  
 heretofore for that purpose.  
 And it appearing to this Town that some matters contained  
 in their Instructions, are of such a Nature that it would be inde-  
 cent for them to Stand upon the Records of this Town. — But that  
 Clerk shall keep them on file. And any person (paying him therefore)  
 may have a Copy of said Instructions with the proceeding of this  
 Meeting and all the proceedings on that matter previous to this  
 Signing them. — And that Doc<sup>r</sup> Low & M<sup>r</sup>. Cutts be serv<sup>d</sup>. by  
 the Town Clerk with a Copy of these Votes seasonably, with the Number  
 of Votes for & against it be inserted.

 being made into a Separate State, are hereby revoked, recinded  
 and maid null & void  
 2ndly That Docr Nathel, Low, & M. Richard [Fo?] Cutts who were chosen  
 Delegates at any former meeting, to Represent this Town at  
 Said Convention are Hereby Discharged from said trust  
 and are not to join said Conventions, under the Authority  
 of this Town, Notwithstanding any votes which have been passed  
 heretofore for that purpose.  
 And it appearing to this Town that some matters contained  
 in their instruction, are of such a Nature that it would be inde-  
 cent for them to Stand upon the Records of this Town. — But that  
 Clerk shall keep them on file. And any person (paying him therefore)  
 may have a copy of said Instructions with the proceeding of this  
 Meeting and all the proceedings on that matter previous to this  
 Signing them — And that Doc Low & M. Cutts be served by  
 the Town Clerk with a copy of these Votes seasonably, with the Number  
 of Votes for & against it be inserted.
