1 pound of Salls 1 cup full / of molasses 2 table spoons full / of ginger. Dissolved in 2 milk quarts / of hot water. to be given to the cow / from a bottle, at one time. / Then take tincture of aconite / one half a teaspoon full and pour it on her tongue. This (the aconite) / to be repeated every four hours / until she is relieved. The cow to / be kept warm and syringed / with warm soap suds. / After the cow is better great care must / be taken, not to give her too much to eat at first.
