Company, (G,) 22nd Regiment of Maine Infantry
VOLUNTEERS who has enrolled on the Tenth day of September
one thousand eight hundred and sixty two to serve nine months years or
during the war is hereby Discharged of the service of the United States,
this fourteenth day of August 1863, at Bangor
Maine by reason of Expiration of Terms of Service
(No objection to his being re=enlisted is known to exist. \*)
Said Henry Oliver was born in Houlton
in the State of Maine, is eighteen years of age,
Five feet nine inches high, Light complexion, Blue eyes,
Sandy hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
Given at Bangor this Fourteenth day of
August 1863

\*This sentence will be erased should there be anything in the conduct or in the physical condition of the soldier rendering him unfit for the Army [A.G.O. No. 99.]
