Description: Letter to Parker Cleaveland from Boston book dealers

Boston 8 June 1818


Mr Cleaveland

Dear Sir,

Yours of the 4 inst. respecting Mineralogy sent to Eng. is this day rec^d. On reference to your letter we find you request us to have in readiness 8 Copies Mineral. to be sent to Europe as soon as Dr Vaughan sh^d give direction: & also that we direct 2 copies named by y^r self to individuals.

On reference to Dr Vaughans Letters, we find as follows — "Mr B.Vaughan requests Mess". Cummings & Hilliard to deliver 8 copies of Mr Cleavelands book on Mineralogy to Mr Snow; addressing the same to William Vaughan Esq". of London, on the cover of the Box containing them. The books need only be in boards" — This is the only direction we recd from Dr Vaughan.

From this it appears that Dr V. might have supposed you had given this particular direction. & of course omitted it himself. —Longman & C°. Booksellers London, have in all probability a supply of the Mineralogy, as we sent



them about fifty.

We regret we had not the pleasure of seeing you here at Election. Your visits are vane ——
