Description: Annie Winslow letter to her husband

Washington, D.C. May 14, 1907. I shook hands with our President at 2:30 this afternoon, and said to him, "I have left five children to shake hands with you," and he replied, "good citizen, mighty glad to see you," and laughed very heartily. I was one of the first few hundred to hear his address of welcome, and he received two thousand from the Baptist Convention who were admitted by ticket. I went with Mr Conklin and sister. Had my picture in an Automobile, and will send you one, Annie P. Winslow.
