Portland June 7th 1821

My Dear

I arrived at Portland monday afternoon, where I have been waiting for Doct^r Smith untill this day he arrived in Portland this day about noon – he has consented to come to Baldwin, with me, but he has engagements to go to Saco and I am going with him he has calls to see patients at Gorham & Buxton and I am affaid that I shall not be able to get home untill Saturday night or Sunday. I have seen Professor Cleveland he told me that saw Josiah in Boston and that he expects to be in Portland this week – you must not be concerned if I should not get home untill next week for Doct^r Smith has so many Calls that it is very uncertain how long it will take me to get him to Baldwin I write this lest you should be anxious about my being gone so long ----
