## Woburn 24th March 1798

Dear Sir

I send you enclosed the memorial & petition of the proprietors of Flintstown, also the votes & proceedings of the last proprietors meeting, by which you will perceive that you are appointed their Agent to present their memorial & petition to the Court of general Sessions of the Peace for the County of Cumberland respecting Road, &c. and to aid the same in the various stages thro, which it may pass, in which I wish you good success.

I have received no advice from Count Rumford since I forwarded to him the protest of Salleys Last bills, I hope your good mother will not suffer on account of that money without leting me know of it.
