Description: Petition regarding will of Rishworth Jordan

To the Hon<sup>b</sup> Stephen Thatcher Esq<sup>r</sup> Judge of Probate &<sup>c</sup> for the County of York. --

We the Subscribers, Children, & Heirs to the Estate of the Hon<sup>b</sup> Rishworth Jordan Esquire, late of Biddeford in said County Deceased; Request Your Honor, to Appoint Ralph Tristram Jordan of s<sup>d</sup> Biddeford Esq<sup>r</sup> - he being one of our Brothers, & also an Heir to said Estate. As Administrator on the Estate of the Aforesaid Rishworth Jordan Esquire Deceas<sup>d</sup>. - As we conceive it necessary that Admin =istration be made on s<sup>d</sup> Estate, as soon as may be, and desire that your Honor would Grant would Grant the same, at the next Probate Court held for s<sup>d</sup> County.
