I John Gatchel of Brunswick of lawful age do testify and say 498**

that I have been acquainted with the River called Androscoggin for a number of years; and there is, on the Easterly side of said River. (at a place called the Ten mile falls) an old cellar, which was always reported to be the Place where one Purchase lived, and I never heard it contradicted by any person; but that was always the common Report ever since I can remember which is upward of thirty years
