/Thank you so much for the fine scarf I received a day or two back I am wearing it at the present moment. Out here one appreciates such things from home At present our battalion is in the trenches & as I am in the machine ??? section I am naturally always in the front line. Things seem a bit easier now than when we first came out, the biggest trouble being the wet & mud, it seems incredible the amount of mud there is about. I have been in the thick of it out here for over 10 months now & hope to get my first leave soon, it will be fine to be home for a few days.
