


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Elevator Fire Escape CRIFTION OF PROPERTY April 21, 1916 BOOK 969 PAGE 106 Clayton R. March. Lot 7, Range 13, in Bridgton Center Village. Bounded as follows, to wit:-Commence at a split stone set in the ground on the line estended westerly of the front or southerly side of the store of Ethel & Clara Noone, at a point twalve (12) feet from the southwesterly corner of said store, run Northerly on the west-erly line of said Noones' store lot seventy (70) feet to an iron post set in the ground; thence westerly eighty (80) feet more or less to the sesterly line of the town road called the Peter Nulty Street leading from the road called Main Street to the household of Fred C. Glibs, which was formerly the residence of Peter Nulty to a point seventy (70) feet north-erly from a split stone set in the ground at or near the junction of said two roads or streets; thence run southerly on said easterly side of said street or road called Nulty Street, said seventy (70) feet to said stone and to said Main Street, and thence easterly on said Main Street to the bound begun at.
