

A lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the north side of Main Street, so called, and at the southeasterly corner thereof of the Homestead premises of the late Mildred B. Burnham, and now owned by Lillian M. Bardsley, thence run easterly by said Street 38 1/2 feet to an iron pipe driven into the ground at the southwest corner of the former homestead premises of Richard C. March, thence northerly, parallel with and 38 1/2 feet from easterly side line of Burnham-Bardsley premises, to the south east corner of land of Austin Taylor, meaning the parcel deeded him by Adelaide W. Faine and thence westerly 38 1/2 feet by said Taylor's said land to the line of Burnham-Bardsley premises; thence southerly to the last named premises to point of beginning.
