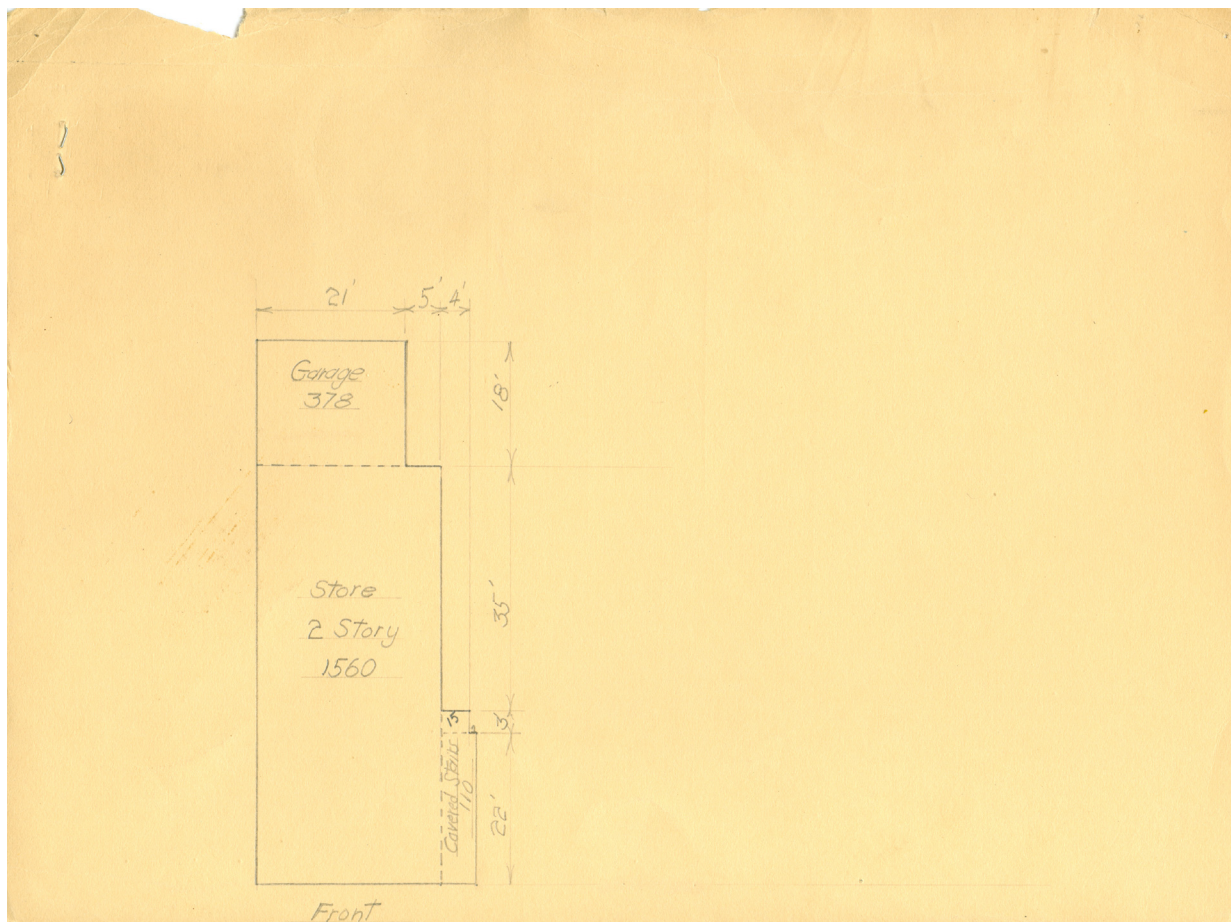

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Boundaries of Eddy Smith's Store lot:- Commence at a point on said Street marked by an iron rod driven in the ground at the southwesterly corner of a lot of land formerly owned by Mildred B. Burnham and now far a long time hereto used as a tennis court and thence run Westerly on the northerly side line of street to a point marked by an iron hub driven into the ground at the southeast corner of the store lot of Charles J. Libby; thence run Northerly on Easterly side line of said Libby store lot a distance of approximately (105) feet to land of said Burnham formerly of said Burnham and now believed to be owned by this grantor to a hub driven into the ground; thence run Easterly parallel with said street on Southerly side of said Burnham or Tenney property to an iron hub driven in the ground, and thence run Southerly by said Burnham of Tenney property and said Tennis Court lot to said Street, a distance of approximately one hundred and 5 feet to the point on said street of commencement. Taken from deed of Withe L. Crosby to Eugene Tenney dated Dec. 21, 1921.
