It is Hereby Certified, that it appears from the records of this office, that Horace W Moore, a Private in Company "C", Twelfth Batt'n Infty, Maine Volunteers, Enlisted on the Second day of January, 1864, and was mustered into the United States Service as a Private at New Orleans La, on the Second day of January 1864, for three years, unless sooner discharged. Honorably discharged at Albany N.Y. July 24 1866.
