July 25th 1862

Dearest Carrie

I send this by Sargt. B. F. Robinson Sebec, just discharged for disability from the service. No time to write. Am going to the Steam Boat with him and others. Am well as usual, hearty. Please send me a 1/2 Gros Matches (Orono's) if there is any chance. It has been five days since I heard from you.
