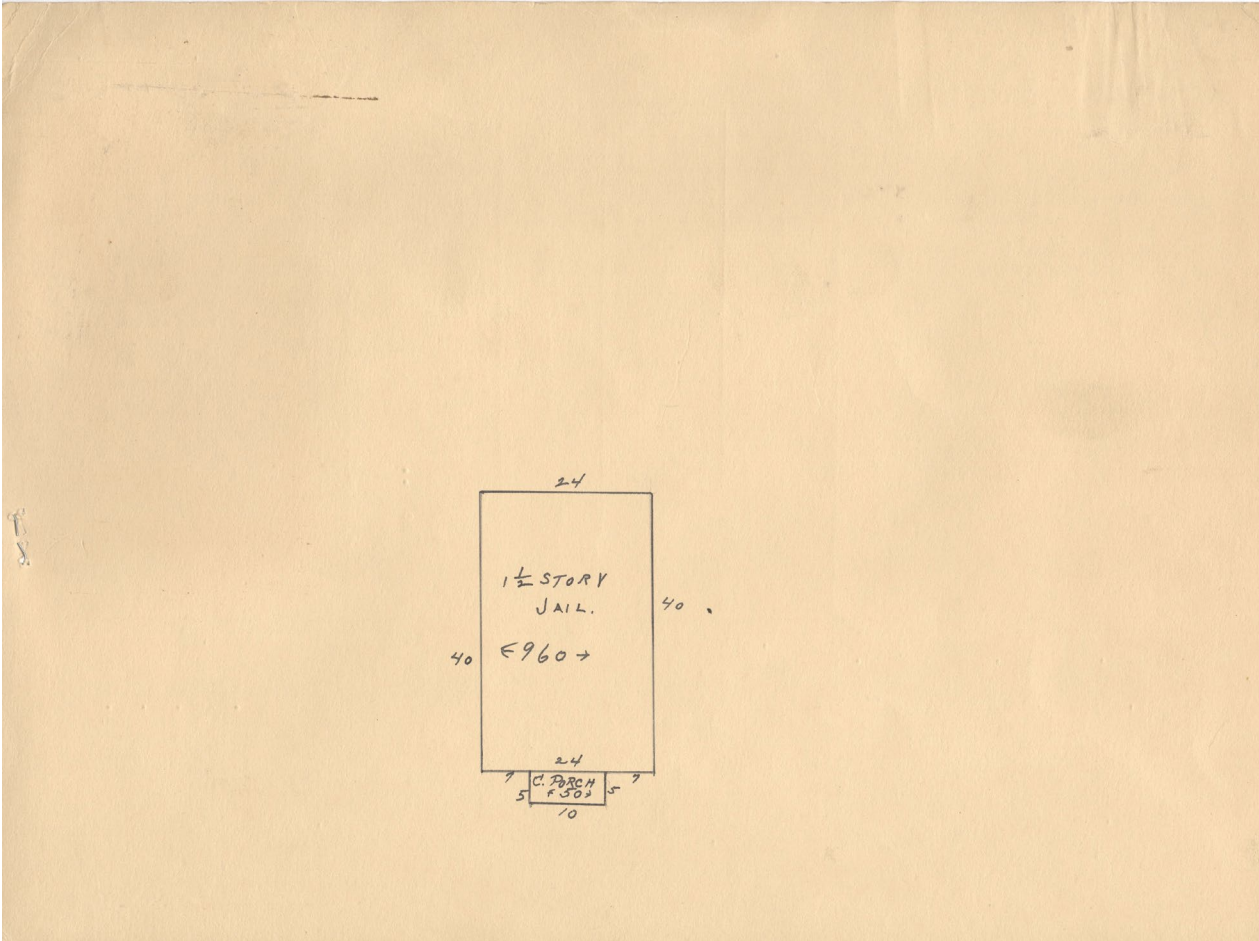

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY: Roof and paint good, cement floor in the jail, 4 cells, front room. BOOK 688-2111 PAGE 338-405 April 30, 1900

A certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Bridgton and in Bridgton Center Village and bounded as follows; to wit:- Commencing at the southwesterly corner of land of Farragut Post No.27 G. A. R. on the easterly side of said Depot Street run easterly on the southerly line of said land of said Farragut Post to Meadow Brook; thence southerly down said brook thirty-six (36) feet to an iron pipe in the ground; thence westerly parallel with the southerly line of land of said Farragut Post to said Depot Street to an iron pipe in the ground at a point thirty-six (36) feet from the point of commencement; and thence northerly on said Depot Street thirty-six (36) feet to the place of commencement, meaning to convey a strip of land extending from said Depot Street, to said Meadow Brook on the southerly side of the Farragut Post lot, said strip to be thirty-six (36) feet wide for its entire length.
