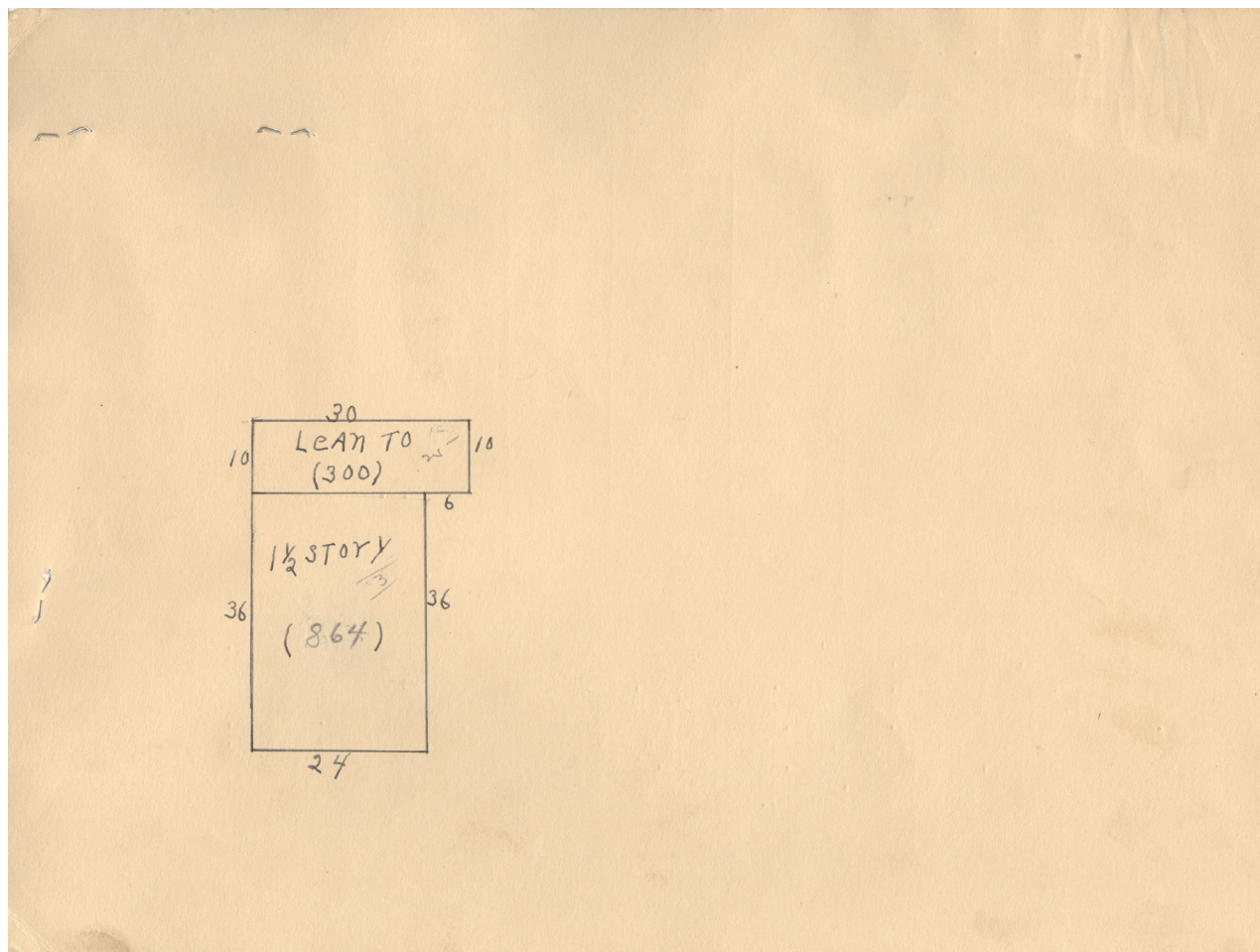

Blacksmith Shop, Depot Street, Walter B. Richardson, bounded as follows;- Commence on the easterly side of said street, and at the south westerly corner thereon of the lot of land originally conveyed by Abel H. Harriman to Winburn W. Staples, now believed to be owned by one Earl R. Brandt, thence run southerly by said street (50) feet, to an iron pipe set in the ground, thence easterly, and at right angles to said street to Meadow Brook, so called, thence up the channel of said brook to the southerly line of said Brandt lot, thence westerly and by said southerly line of said lot mentioned lot to the point on said street begun at.
