


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY First story shop, plank floor BOOK 1420 PAGE 272 May 23, 1933 second story house, roof fair, paint very poor.

Blacksmith Shop, Depot Street, Walter B. Richardson, bounded as follows; - Commence on the easterly side of said street, and at the south westerly corner thereon of the lot of land originally conveyed by Abel H. Harriman to Winburn W. Staples, now believed to be owned by one Earl R. Brandt, thence run southerly by said steet (50) feet, to an iron pape set in the ground, thence easterly, and at right angles to said street, to Meadow Brook, so called, thence up the channel of said brook to the southerly line of said Brandtlot, thence westerly and by said southerly line of said lot mentioned lot to the point on said street begun at.
