

A certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Town of Bridgton and in Bridgton Center Village and on the southerly side of the Street leading from Main Street in said Village past the house of William Wallace Hazen to the High School Building Lot and laying next easterly and adjacent to same High School Building lot bounded and described as follows, to wit: Commence at the northwesterly corner on said school street of an eight foot strip of land this day deeded said Hazen by myself said Lucy A. Berry, marked by an iron pipe; thence westerly viz: south sixty-eight degrees west fifty two feet to an iron pipe supposed to be driven at the point of intersection of the easterly side line of said School Lot with the southerly side line of said Street, said last corner running by said School Street; thence by said School lot running south four degrees and thirty minutes west to Depot Street; thence southerly by said Depot Street to the southwesterly corner of said eight foot strip this day deeded as aforesaid, thence north about fifteen degrees west by the westerly side line of



said eight-foot strip to School Street aforesaid and the point thereon of commencement and bound first mentioned, meaning to convey all the land which I own laying between said School Building Lot and land of said Hazen on the southerly side of said School Street.
