


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY very poor condition, just a shack. BOOK

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in said Bridgton Center Village and bounded and described as follows: to wit: Commence at the southwesterly corner of the Blacksmith shop lot owned by Charles J. Wentworth, now occupied and supposed to be owned by George Douglass, on the easterly side of Depot Street, thence run southerly on said Sepot Street fifty (50) feet; thence easterly at right angles with said Depot Street to Meadow Brook, so-called; thence northerly on said Brook to the southerly side line of said Blacksmith shop lot; and thence westerly on said line and bound to the point of commencement and bound begun at.
