My dear Miss Mountfort,

I received your letter the next day after it was mail'd, I thank you for giving us the information that all had safely ~~arrived~~ arrived, I do not suppose there is much doubt but the medium of the post office is as safe a conveyance as a private one, but we cannot help feeling a little anxiety untill we hear that the money has reached Hager as much on her account as our own. give our love to her if you please and say we are glad to hear she is as well as usual. Our love to your mother also. We enclose six dollars. for Hager, and hope it will cheer her heart.
