Commence on the westerly side line of said street, and at a point therein which is on a course bearing 46 3/4 degrees west of south from an oak tree standing on the easterly side of said street nearly opposite the Curtis Gray house so called, said Gray house standing well back from said street, thence from said point run north 80 3/4 degrees west 112 feet to a stake and stone; thence south 9 1/2 degrees west, 75 feet to a stake and stones; thence south 80 1/4 degrees east, 112 feet to said street and thence north 9 1/2 degrees east by said street to the point of commencement thereon.
