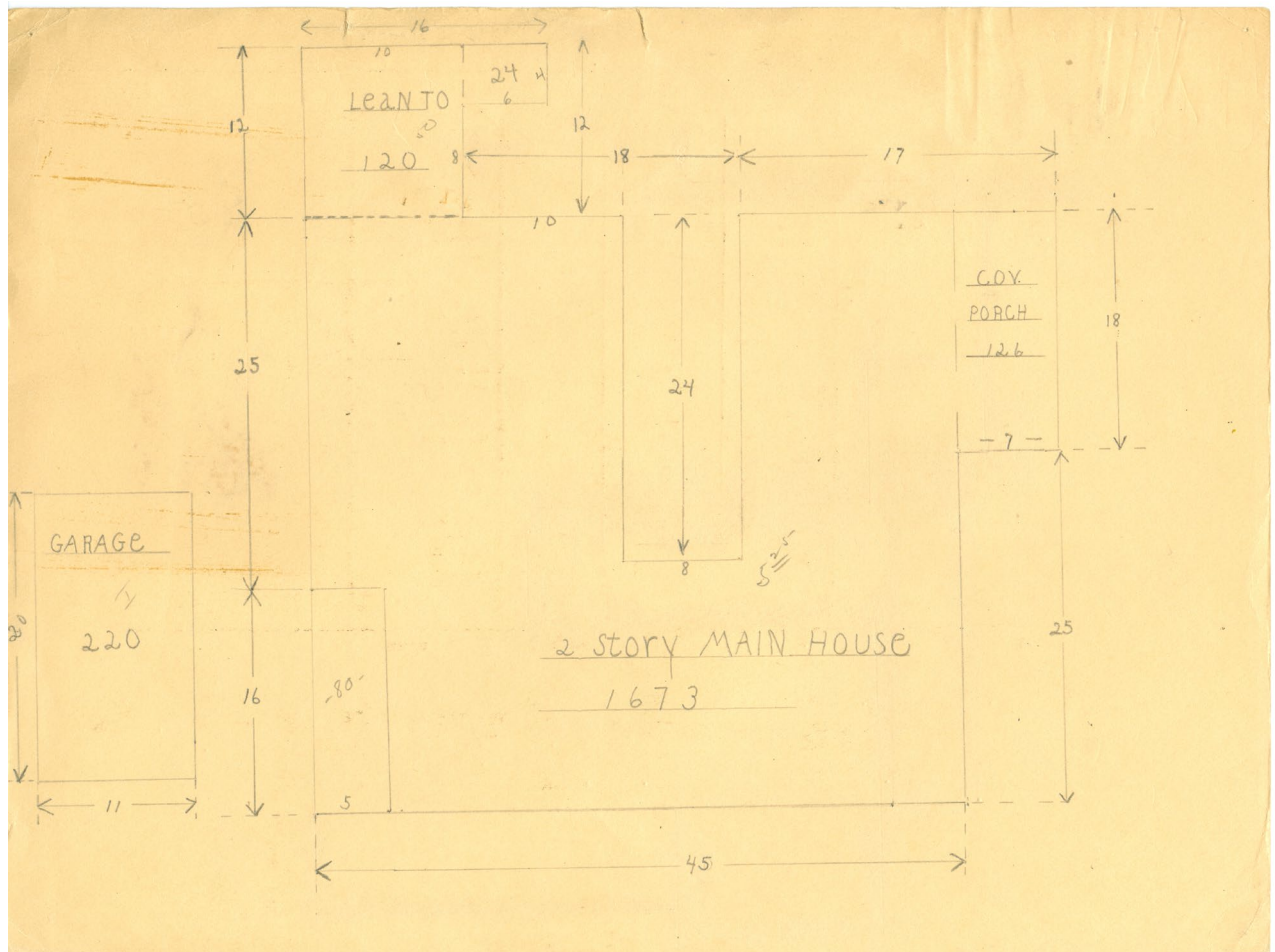

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY Sept. 6, 1897 BOOK 656 PAGE 82

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated on the east side of Portland Street, so called, and being a part of lot #7 in the 15th range and bounded westerly by the Portland Road leading from Pondicherry corner in Bridgton Center to Naples, northerly by the homestead premises of Mary Woodbury, easterly by land of Newell N. Chute and possibly a small piece of land owned by the Pease heirs, and southerly by the homestead lots of George W. Barbour and Clara O. Ham, being the same premises bought by me in three parcels.
