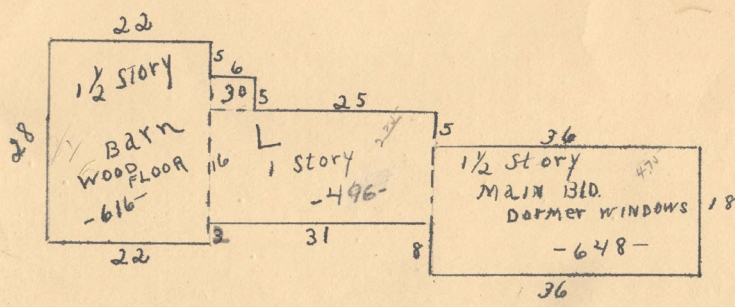

**DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY** 1 1/2 Story Fair Condition. **BOOK** Nov. 1, 1915 **PAGE**

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in said town of Bridgton and in Bridgton Center Village on the westerly side of Flint Street, so called, therein, being a part of lot numbered (7) in the 14th range of the said town lots. Bounded and described as follows:- Commence on the westerly side line of said Flint Street and at the northeasterly corner of land now owned by trustees of Charity Fund of Oriental Lodge formerly by Frank Gibbs. Thence run South 73 3/4 degrees and west 22 feet; thence South 16 1/2 degrees West, 4 ft., Thence North 77 1/2 degrees West, one hundred and six feet, to land of heirs of late Joseph L. Wales and Cumberland Lodge # 30 L.C.O.F. being the old Gibbs, Fowler & Wales Store lot. Thence northerly and by said last mentioned land 64 ft. to land of J. Henry Halkett formerly owned by Jefferson Gallison; thence easterly and by said Halkett -Gallison land to said Flint Street, Formerly called the North Bridgton Road. Thence Southerly by said street or road to the point thereon begun at. Reserving and excepting from the operation of this conveyance a right of way 12 feet wide over the southerly side of conveyed premises for the use of parties now enjoying same under grants made previous to the date of this deed. The above mentioned magnetic courses were registered in Sept. 1874. For the original description of this land conveyed Reference is made to deed of Pondicherry Mills Co., to Alexander Lumsden dated Sept. 21, 1874

recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds Page 357, Book 412. My title being under deed of Thomas Easton to me dated Jan. 6, 1903 and as of this date unrecorded but to be recorded herewith
