DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY: 1 story warehouse-good condition

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"A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situate in said Bridgton, a part of lot numbered seven in the thirteenth range of said town's lots lying on the easterly side of Bennett, Street, so called, in said Bridgton Center Village, bounded as follows:- Commence on said side of said street at the center of a large rock which is the northwesterly corner thereon of the old Isaac Chase homestead lot; thence run North twenty-nine and one fourth degrees West by said street a distance of about sixty-three feet to an iron pipe; thence north sixty-one degrees East nine rods and nineteen links to an iron pipe driven in a ditch supposed to be on line of land formerly owned by Lucy A. Berry; thence southeasterly by said Berry land to a corner of said Isaac Chase lot; thence westerly by said Chase lot to the corner thereof begun at, to wit, said large rock. Being the same premises conveyed to the Grantors by Frank L. Wilson by deed dated April 26, 1928 and recorded in the Cumberland Registry of Deeds, Book 1290, Page 285. Also a certain lot or parcel of land adjoining the above described parcel, situate in said Bridgton and in Bridgton Center Village and on the Northeasterly side of Bennett Street, bounded and described as follows: Commence on said Northeasterly side of said Bennett Street, and at the Southwesterly corner thereon of the above described premises, said corner being formerly the corner



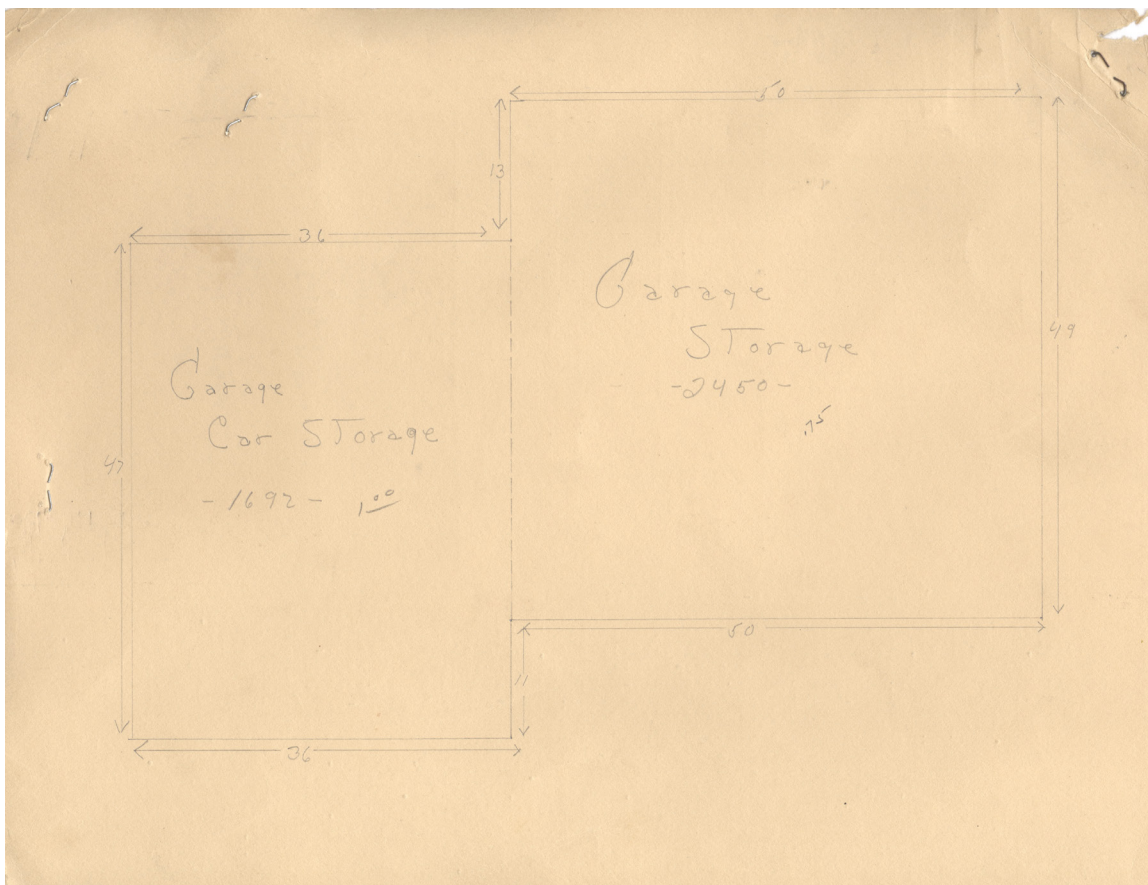
