



20 Cottage Street, Henry R. Andrews, Part of lot (7) Range (13) bounded and described as follows:Commence on the easterly side of Cottage St., and said Village, and at the Northeasterly corner thereon
of the present homestead premises of Cora E. Searles, thence Southerly and by the Easterly side line
of said Searles homestead premises and continuing on beyond the same and in line of direction with
said Easterly side line thereof to Church St., thence Easterly by said Church St. to Fowler St., thence
Northerly by said Fowler St., (222) feet more or less to said Cottage St., and thence Westerly
