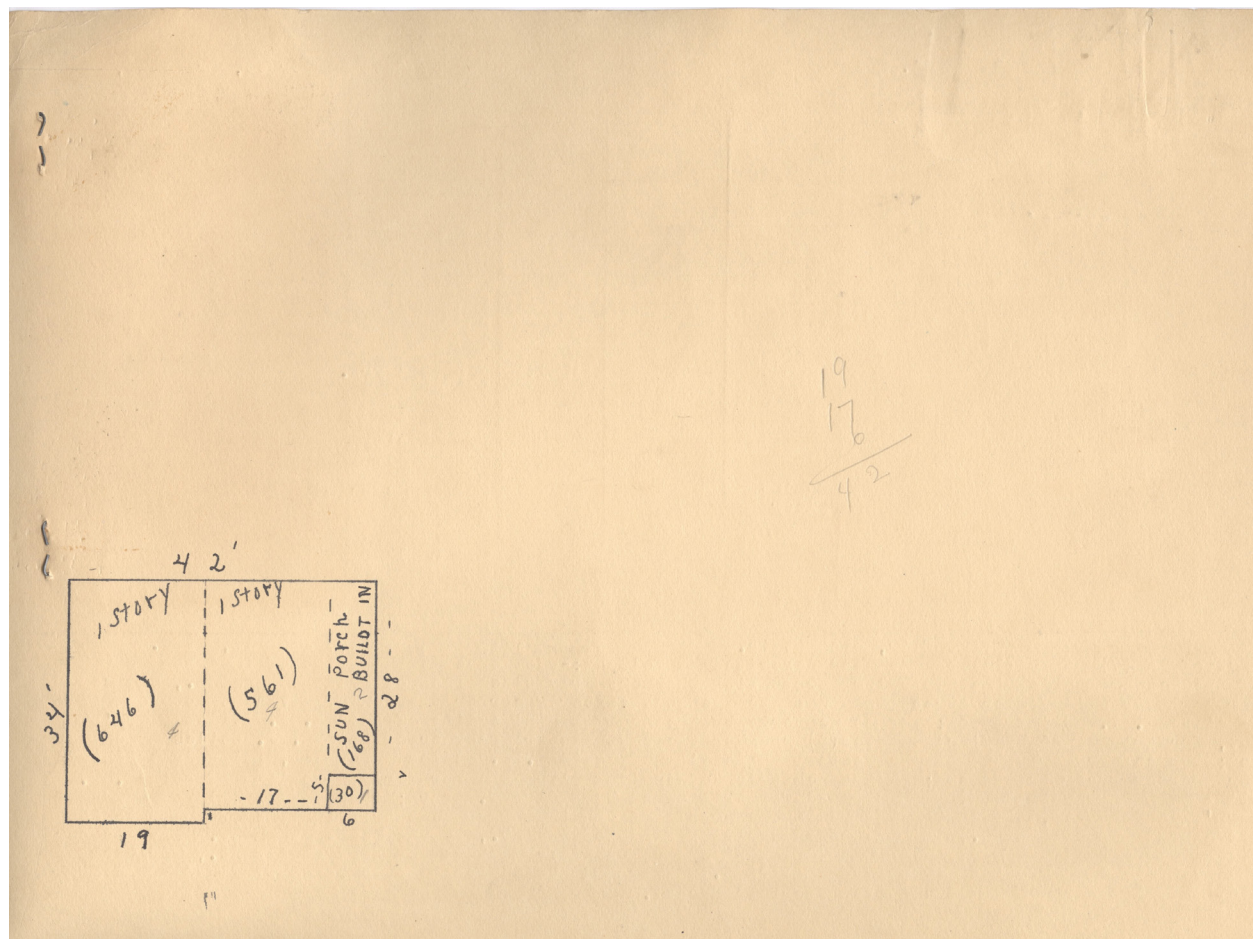

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY Paint fair, open attic. BOOK 1443 PAGE 477 July 17, 1934.
Part of lot (7) Range (13) bounded and described as follows:- Commence at the point of intersection of the westerly side line of Fowler Street with the northerly side line of said Cottage St., thence northerly by said Fowler Street 23 links to the southeasterly corner thereof of a vacant lot now owned by E. J. Stiles & Son; thence westerly by the southerly side line of said E. J. Stiles & Son's lot, formerly owned by Vincent Yates (6) rods to the southwesterly corner of said E. J. Stiles & Son lot; thence northerly and by the westerly side line of said E. J. Stiles & Son lot, (6) rods to the northwesterly corner thereof; thence westerly and in line with the northerly side line of said E. J. Stiles & Son lot about (2) rods to land formerly owned by Claire B. Burn; thence southerly by said Burn's land to wit, the easterly side line thereof and continuing on southerly in line of the same to the aforesaid Cottage St., and thence easterly by said Cottage St., to the point begun at. Also another parcel being a part of lot (7) Range (13) bounded as follows:- Easterly by said Fowler St., northerly by the homestead premises formerly of Edward C. Walker and now supposed to be owned by Floyd Moulton southerly and westerly by the above described parcel.
