**DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY** Paint fair, shingles poor.

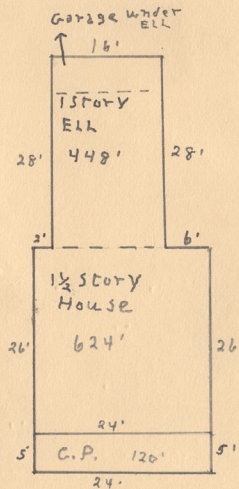
22 Cottage Street, Cora E. Searles, May 29, 1918, bounded as follows:- Commence at an iron stake driven in the ground on the southerly side of said Cottage St., and at a point about (77) feet easterly of Gage St., thence run South (23) degrees and (20)' minutes East ( course taken Oct. 1912) and through the center of a well to an iron bolt corner standing on said course and at a point thereon (65 1/2) feet southerly of the center of said well; thence from said last named corner, south (66) degrees and (40) minutes West, being a right angle to the first course run, about (66) feet to said Gage Street; thence northerly by said Gage Street, to its junction with said Cottage Street, and thence easterly, by said Cottage St., to the point begun at. Also another parcel of land adjoining the one above mentioned bounded as follows:- Commence on the easterly side of Gage St., and at the southwest corner of the above described premises, thence run easterly and by the southerly line of said above described premises (meaning the line of said lot that runs through the center of a well) to said Church Street, thence Westerly and by said Gage St; thence northerly by said Gage Street. to the point thereon begun at.
