DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY 1 1/2 Story, fair condition

From Emma R. Nteeros to Gertrude L. Walsh... Commence on the easterly side of said Elm Street, and at the southwesterly corner of the homestead premises of John L. Lamb, - thence run easterly, and on the southerly line of said Lamb's said premises, to land owned by Edward T. Alley at the time of his decease, then run southerly on the line of said Alley land to a point thereon exactly opposite of the center of a well, and to land formerly owned by Mildred B. Burnham, now owned by the heirs of Lillian M. Bardsley, thence westerly and on the northerly line of said Burnham- Bardsley land, the line being parallel with the southerly side of the house on the premises now being described and hereby deeded, to said Elm Street thence northerly by said Elm Street to the point thereon of commencement. Reserving the right of use and occupancy of the land lying between the house on the lot above described and the southerly line of said lot; and I do hereby convey the perpetual use and occupancy of the land lying between the southerly line of this lot and northerly of the house on the said Burnham- Bardsley premises, to be used in common with the owners, from time to time, of said last named premises. Also I do hereby convey unto the Grantee hereof a certain other lot or parcel of land lying next adjacent to and adjoining the above described and hereby conveyed lot, on the easterly side thereof, bounded and described as follows:
