


DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY 2 Story fair condition.

Lillian M. Bardsley to J. T. Bardsley (house on Elm Street, Commence at a granite post(its top even with the surface of the ground) marking the point of intersection of the easterly side-line of said Elm Street with the Northerly side-line of said Main Street, — then run Easterly by said Main Street to the southwesterly corner thereon of the homestead premises lot of Adeline W. Paine, — once a part of the "E. T. Alley property, an iron pipe griven into the ground marking said corner; thence northerly and by the westerly side-line of said Paine's said homestead-lot, — the course thereof, this day taken, registering North twenty-six(26) degrees and forty-five (45) minutes East, to a point easterly and exactly opposite of the center of the well on the boundary-line of the lot now being described and hereby conveyed, and the homestead-lot of Austin W. Taylor, formerly owned by Albert F. Segon; thence westerly in a straight line parallel with the southerly side of the house of said Taylor (on said Taylor-Segon lot) to said Elm Street, and thence Southerly by said Elm Street to its junction as aforesaid with said Main Street, being the point of beginning.
