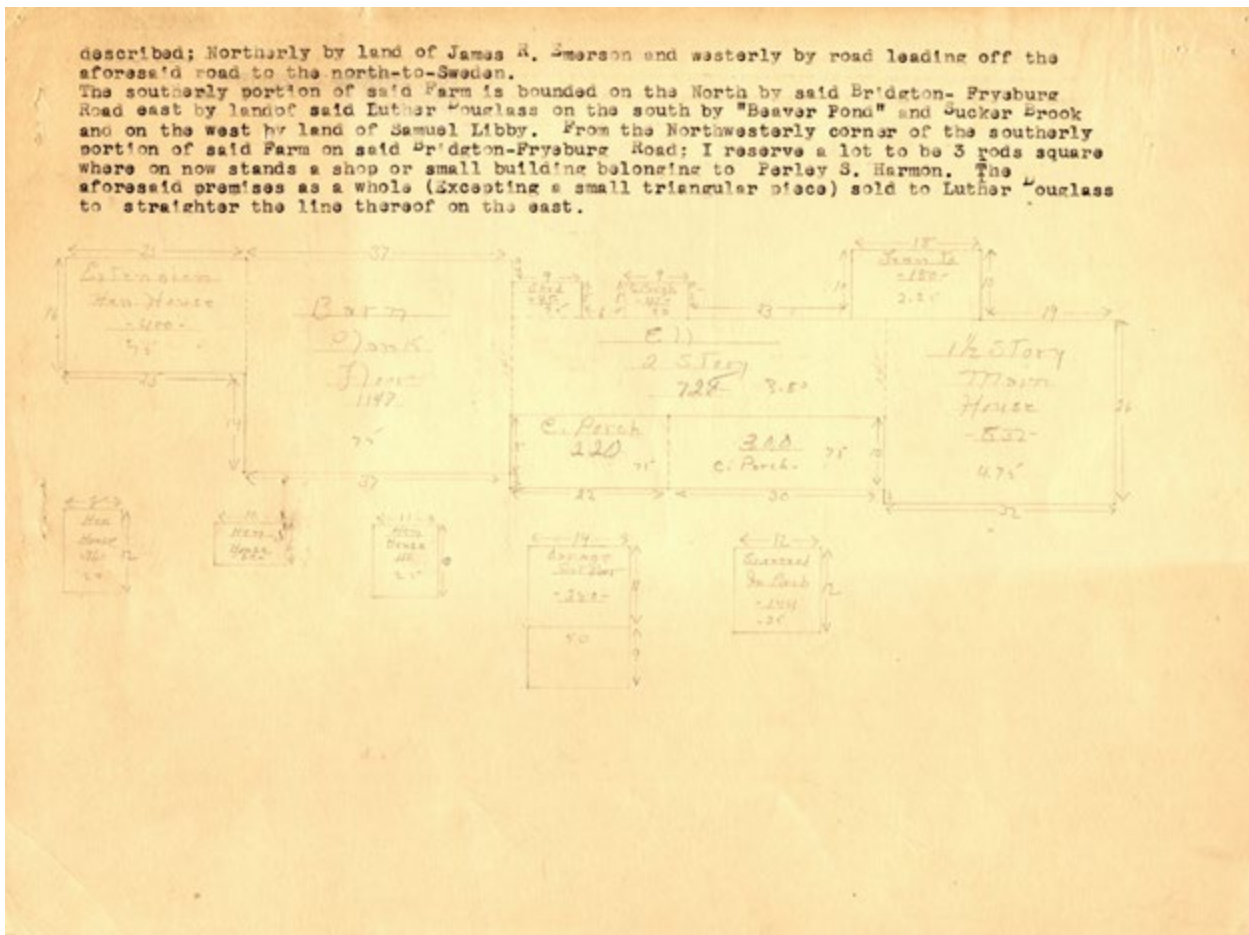

Wiley by deed Oct. 12, 1907, recorded in Cumbl. Rec. of deeds, book 814, page 255, to which deed and deeds therein referred to and their referents may be had.

This property as recorded by Charles S. Wiley of Fryeburg in book 716 page 420 dated Aug. 25, 1899. Certain real estate situated in said town of Bridgton called Pumpkin Valley being my late homestead farm lying on the northerly and southerly sides of the road leading from Bridgton to Fryeburg; the northerly portion of said farm on which stand the buildings; bounded as follows:- southerly by said Bridgton-Fryeburg road; easterly by land of Luther Douglass as the wall now stands dividing his homestead premises from the land now being
