Sir.

You are required to proceed with your Comp^y to Pownalborough & Fort Weston on Kennebeck River without delay. You will Divide your Force at these two places & employ them in small parties scouting in proper places to prevent the Cattle of the inhabitants of that river from being driven off by lurking parties of the Enemy & to prevent any Molestation of the inhabitants, or do whatever shall appear to you to be most for their security. You will apply to major Roland Cushing or Esqr Bowman at Pownalbr & Col^l W^m Howard at Fort Weston for Quarters & Supplies. Be active & vigilant & give me an Account of your proceedings as often as may be with Convenience. Wishing you Success I am Sir
