

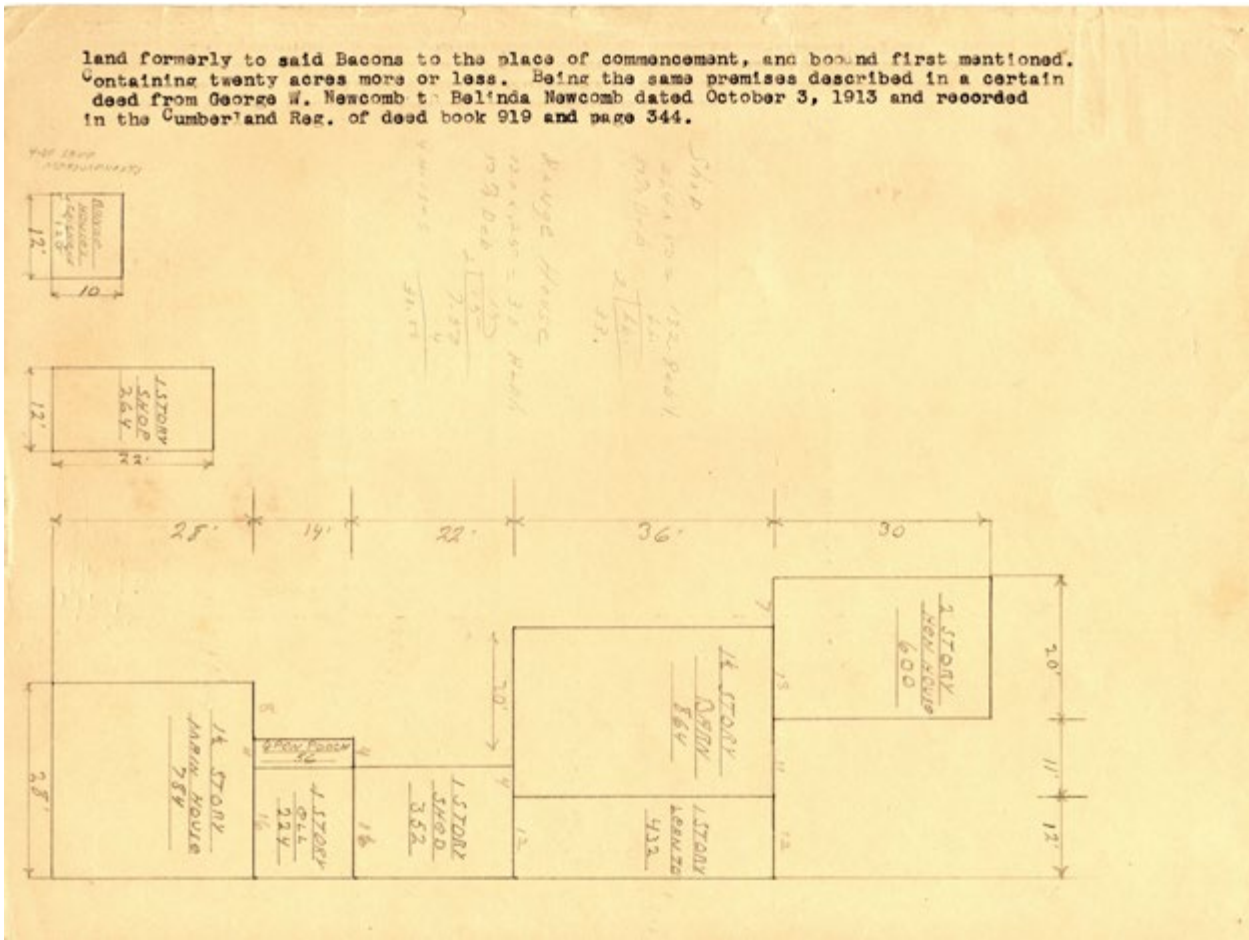

A certain lot or parcel of land together with the buildings thereon situated in said Bridgton, being my present homestead premises formerly known as the "William S. Quincy" farm and later known as the "Austin Newcomb, bounded as follows to wit: - commence at the southeasterly corner of land formerly owned by Eva L. and Mary S. Bacon and now owned by Fred S. Quincy on the westerly side of south High St. so called and the Northeasterly corner of the lot herein conveyed; thence run southerly by said street to the homestead premises formerly of Chas. S. Roberts and now owned or occupied by Perley L. Lombard; thence westerly on the northerly line of said Lombard land a stone wall and wire fence dividing the land herein conveyed from other land of Fred S. Quincy said wall and fence being in the same general course as the line of said Roberts land to the late homestead premises of George H. Davis; thence northerly by the Easterly line of said Davis homestead to land of said Quincy formerly of said Bacons, thence easterly by the southerly line of said Quincy
