

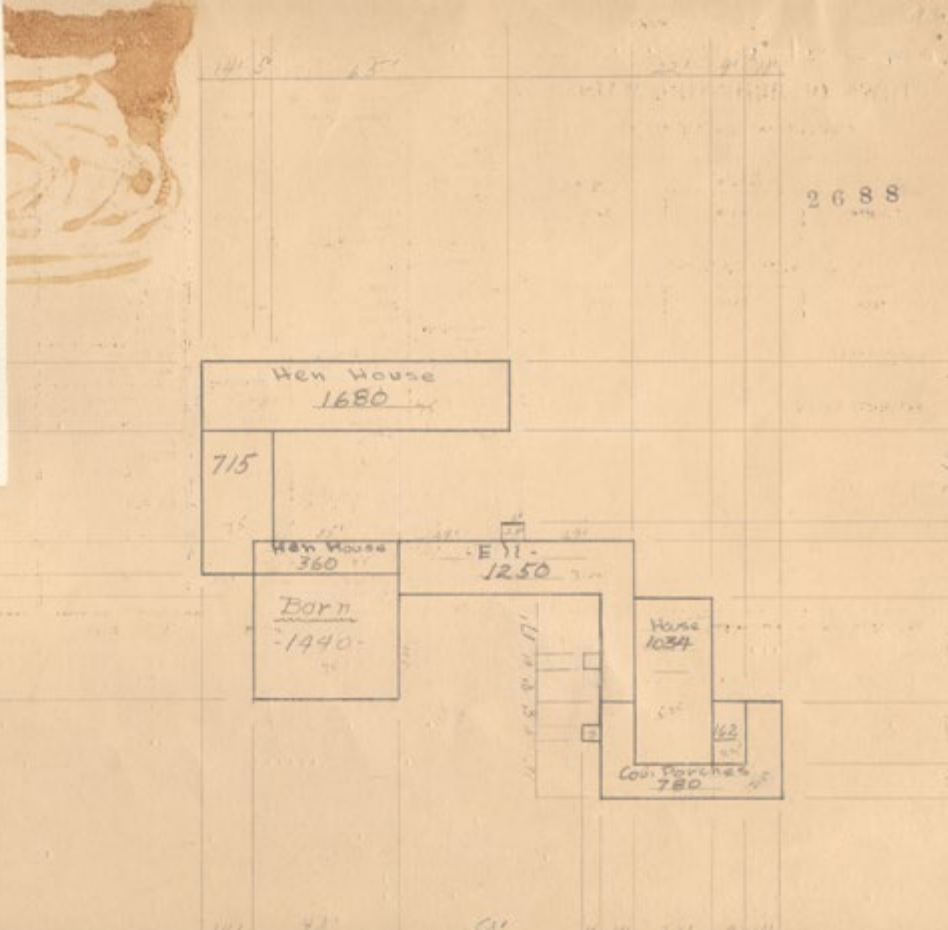

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY Listed for 120 acres

Good condition... A certain parcel of real estate with the buildings thereon situate in said Bridgton and in that part thereof known as and called the "Valley" bounded and described as to adjacent ownership and occupancy as follows: Northerly by the so called Fryeburg Road known as the Roosevelt Trail and leading from said Bridgton to Fryeburg; Easterly, by a part of the homestead premises of C. Lester Ames, timberland of said Emma R. Libby, and timber land of said Ames, Southerly by timberland of the heirs of J. Louville Bennett; Westerly by timber or wood land.

QUIT CLAIM DEED FROM J. BENNETT PIKE TO ELLA H. KELLAR..... Book 1481 Page 330, Feb. 15, 1936...

A certain lot or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situate in said Bridgton and in that part thereof known as the "Valley" bounded and described as to adjacent ownership and occupancy as follows:--- Northerly by the so called Fryeburg Road, known as the Roosevelt Trail and leading from said Bridgton to Fryeburg; Easterly by a part of the homestead of C. Lester Ames, timberland now or formerly of Emma A. Libby and timberland of said Ames, Southerly by timberland of the heirs of J. Louville Bennett; Westerly by timber or woodland owned by Florence Bradford, meadow land of said Ames and homestead premises of William Hewson, formerly owned by Albert E. Cole.
