

Cow medicine
 for milk fever
 Mr. McLellan the cow doctor from
 Saccarappa recommended

1 pound of Salts 1 cup full
 of molasses 2 table spoons full
 of ginger. Dissolved in 2 milk quarts
 of hot water. to be given to the cow
 from a bottle at one time.
 Then take Tincture of Aconite
 one half a teaspoon full and pour
 it on her tongue This (the Aconite)
 to be repeated every four hours
 until she is relieved. The cow to
 be kept warm and syringed
 with warm soap suds
 After the cow is better great care must
 be taken, not to give her too much
 to eat at first.
