

Cure for Heaves in a horse

Take one set of cattles feet, wash them perfectly clean, without removing the hoofs or hairs; [cook] them perfectly [tinded] till they are of a consistency to strain, after straining take one part of the liquid + mix with meal and spread a little dry meal over it + give it to the horse, + if he does not eat it soon, sprinkle a little more meal over it And by the time the liquid is gone from one set of feet a cure will be affected Remove all the rib.

For lameness in horses shoulder, [bleed] on the inside of the sore leg, half way between the knee + body.

Inflammation in horses eyes Syringe with camphorated spirits.
