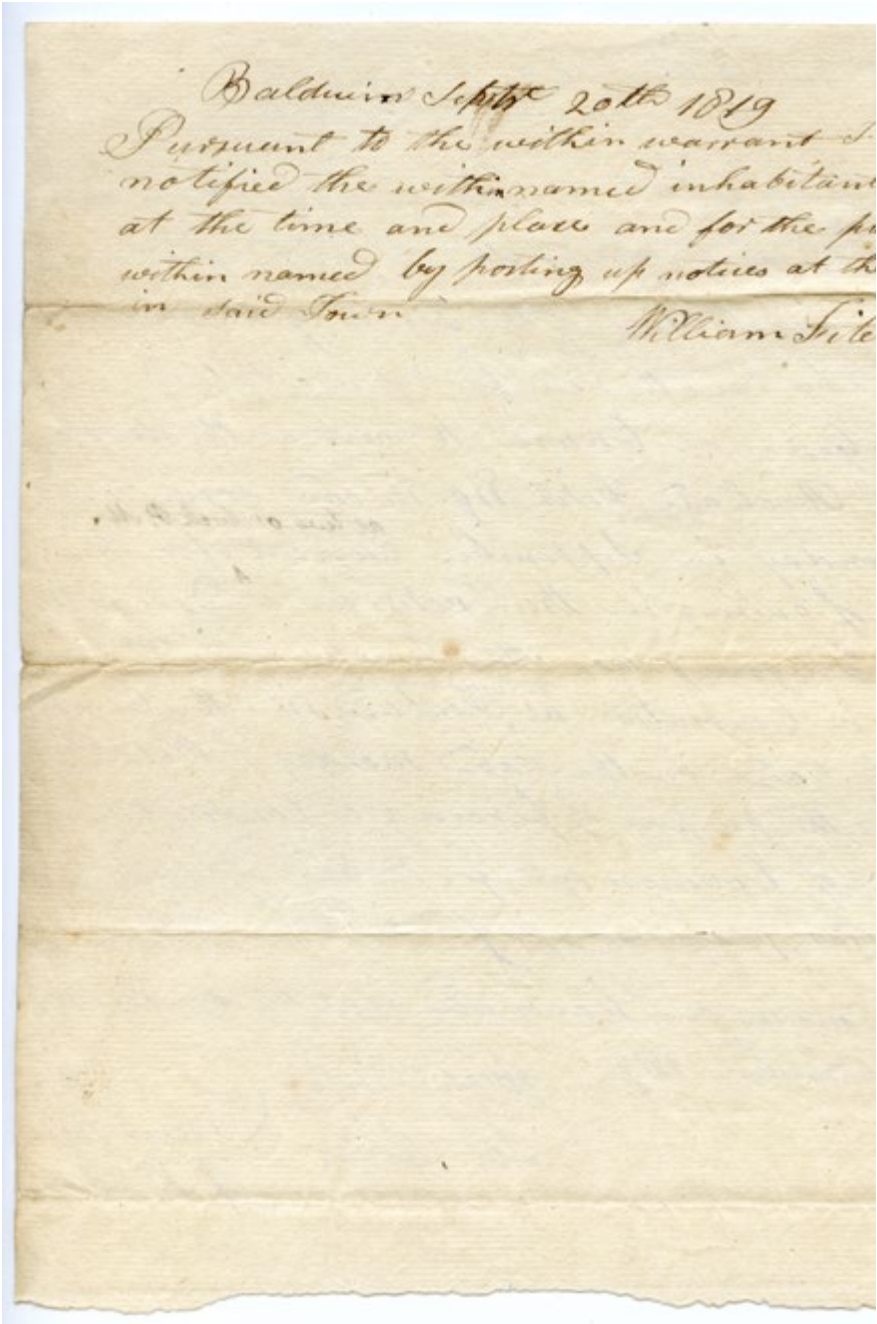
Greetings

 monweath of Massachusetts to notify and warn
 the male inhabitants of the Town of Baldwin
 qualified by law to vote for representatives -----
 to the General Court to meet at the dwelling
 house of Richard Fitch Esq in said town on the
 at two o'clock P.M.
 third Monday on September current ^ for the
 purpose of giving in their votes for a Delegate,
 to meet Delegates from other Towns within the said
 at court house in
 District, in Convention at ^ Portland, in the County
 of Cumberland on the second Monday of October
 next, for the purpose of forming a Constitution
 or Frame of Government, for the said District,
 and for other purposes expressed in said Act”

Given under our hands and seal the sixth day
of September 1819
