Cumberland & Brunswick Aug' 11. 1763.  
Then Stephen Gatchell Surveyor of Land personally appeared  
Before me William Woodside one of his Majestys Justices  
of the Peace for said County and made Oath that the Black  
Line marked A at the West End is over a True and a due  
West Course from the twelve rod road. All which was  
done according to his best Skill & Judgment.
