Know all Men by these presents that I Loamme Baldwin of Woburn In the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Esquire have authorized constituted and appointed Josiah Pierce of Baldwin formerly called Flintstown in the County of Cumberland and Commonwealth aforesaid Esquire. To be my lawful attorney and I Do by these presents authorize constitute and appoint the said Josiah to pay all the Taxes which may be lawfully aforesaid to me on account of land belonging to me lying in said Baldwin and to and transact all business respecting said taxes which as a proprietor of said said Lands I might or ought to do myself and I do further authorize constitute and appoint the said Josiah Pierce with full and compleat power to redeem all my lands in a Lawful manner which have hither to been sold or may be sold for the purpose of collecting Taxes Legally afoeseed to me and to do and perform all things respecting my lands in said Baldwin as far as regards the payment of said taxes and redemption of lands sold as aforesaid. In testimony of all which I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three
