Know ye, that GEORGE H. SWEET a Private of Captain Lester Dwinels Company "G" 15th Regiment of Me Infantry Veteran Volunteers, who was enrolled on the 16th day of January one thousand eight hundred and sixty five to serve Two years or during the war, is hereby discharged from the service of the United States, this 5th day of July 1866 at Charleston, South Carolina by reason of Muster out organization.

Said GEORGE H. SWEET was born in the State of Maine is 18 years of age 5 feet 9 inches high, Fair complexion, Hazel eyes, Brown hair and by occupation when enrolled a Farmer.
