You are hereby notified and warn the inhabitants of the Said town of Cumberland qualified by law to vote in town affairs to assemble at their town house in said town on Tuesday the first day of November next, at one o'clock, P.M. to act on the following articles, to wit

First, To have a moderator to preside at Said meeting

Second, To See if the town will raise Money for the purpose of procuring volunteers: in anticipation of an other call from the President of the U. S.

Third, To See what action the town will take to carry the above object into effect

Given under our hands at Cumberland this 25th day of October A.D. 1864
