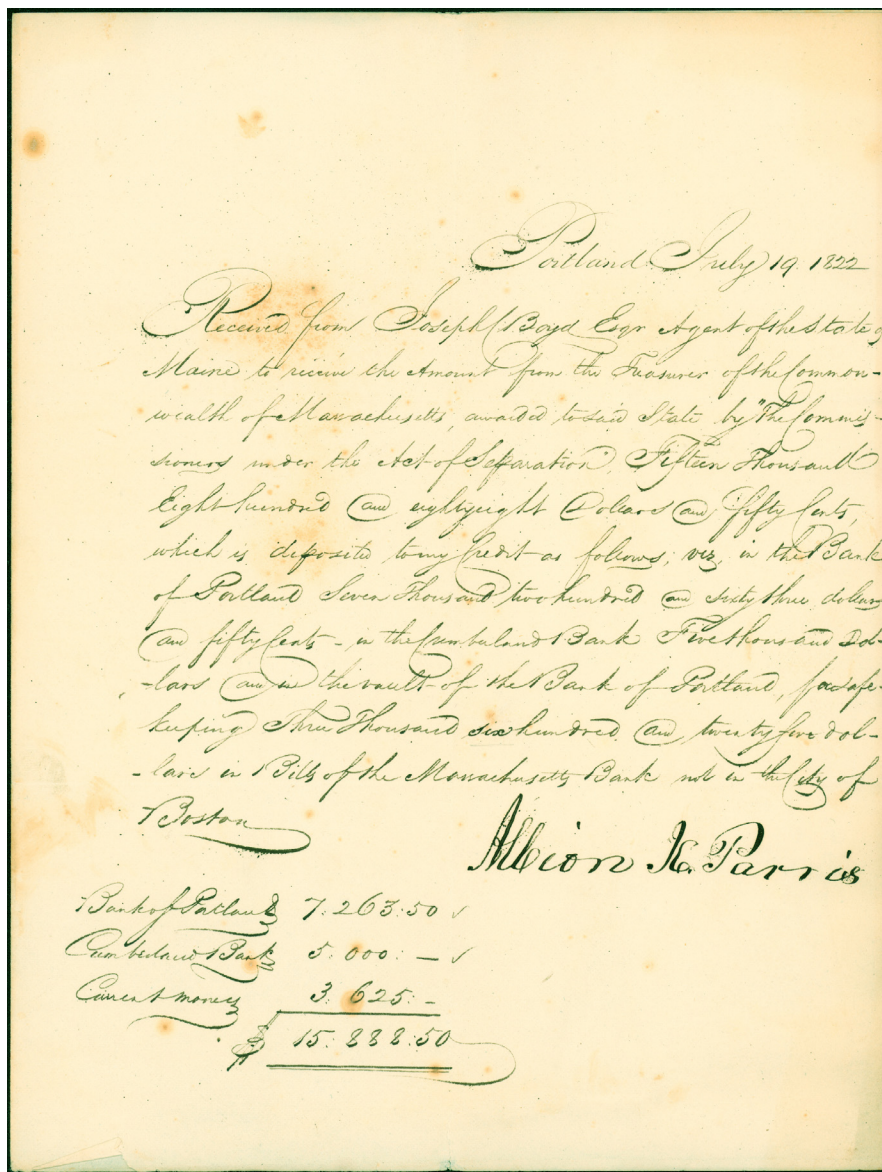


Portland July 19 1822

Received from Joseph Boyd Esqr Agent of the State of Maine to receive the Amount from the Treasurer of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, awarded to said State by "The Commissioners under the Act of Separation", Fifteen Thousand Eight hundred and eighty eight Dollars and fifty Cents, which is deposited to my Credit as follows; viz in the Bank of Portland Seven Thousand two hundred and sixty three dollars and fifty Cents in the Cumberland Bank Five thousand Dollars and in the vault of the Bank of Portland, for safe-keeping Three Thousand Six hundred and twenty five dollars in Bills of the Massachusetts Bank not in the City of Boston
